1.1. Chair

- 1.1.1. Overall implementation of Environmental Management System (EMS) program.
- 1.1.2. Core Team Chair shall schedule and hold meetings for the EMS Core Team and Environmental Advisory Council (EAC) members.
- 1.1.3. Objectives and targets shall be communicated to both Core and EAC members.
- 1.1.4. Custodian of all records of meetings, minutes, and documents pertaining to EMS.
- 1.2. Core Team Members
 - 1.2.1. Members of the Core Team will be responsible for the implementation of the major components of the EMS.
 - 1.2.2. Meet on a quarterly basis.
 - 1.2.3. Develop and establish new environmental tasks.
- 1.3. Environmental Advisory Council
 - 1.3.1. Members of the Environmental Advisory Council (EAC) shall meet at least twice a year to discuss/implement any environmental matter.
 - 1.3.2. EAC members will communicate to EMS Core Team of any pertinent environmental issues they encounter in their respective fields.
 - 1.3.3. EAC shall assist the EMS Core Team in coordinating/implementing environmental initiatives, such as but not limited to; Earth Day notices, reducing hazardous chemical waste, and energy management.
