PHARMACY SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP:

3+3+1 Pharmacy Program, TX A&M Irma Lerma Rangel College of Pharmacy

Students selected will be assured and interview at the A&M COP.

Eligibility: GPA of 3.2, 20 hours of volunteering or observation in a pharmacy. HS and College students may apply

The application consists of two or three reference letters, TAMIU transcript, resume and personal statement.

Application Deadline: February

DENTAL SCHOOL PARTNERSHIPS:

DEAP 3+4; University of Texas Health Science Center San Antonio (UTHSCSA) School of Dentistry

Eligibility: The student can apply after 12 hours of college hours, but no more than 30 hours. Applicants will be considered based on academic achievement, standardized test scores, community activities, socioeconomic history, awards, honors, knowledge of the profession and letters of recommendation.

Application Deadline: March 31st

DEAP 4+4, University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston School of Dentistry

Applications from individuals are accepted through the Health Professions Advisors on the campuses after the spring semester of the first year of enrollment.

- 1. Applicant must be admitted and currently enrolled at one of the partner schools.
- 2. Applicant must apply to the program prior to the start of their second year. With the support of the Health Professions Advisor
- 3. Applicant must have an acceptable pre-entry interview with UTSD-Houston. The interview is coordinated with the partner school and is conducted at either the partner school or UTSD-Houston. The interview may include the Health Professions Advisor and the Associate Dean for Student and Alumni Affairs or a designated Admissions Committee member. The purpose of the interview is to determine motivation for the dental profession, qualities of character, and the potential for service to the underserved populations of Texas.
- 4. APPLICANT MUST BE A TEXAS RESIDENT.

ALLIED HEALTH PARTNERSHIP:

Laredo Early Acceptance Program (LEAP), University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio,

Students can select to be considered for assured acceptance to Physician Assistant Studies, Respiratory Care, Medical Laboratory Sciences, Occupation Therapy, or Physical Therapy.

Eligibility: 24 SCH 12 being prerequisites for individual program, GPA of 3.2, 20 hours of volunteering or observation in health care setting.

The application consists of two reference letters, TAMIU transcript, resume and personal statement.
