What to expect if you have a Staggs Student in your course?

Progress Reports:

Staggs Administration issues progress reports 4 weeks into the semester to track our students' academic success. Students are responsible for setting up appointments with their professors to ensure the progress reports are complete.

Request of Numerical Averages:

Staggs Administration will be sending an email at the end of the semester to request submission of numerical averages on a 100 point scale. Grades are to be submitted through the grade portal. Numerical averages are necessary to issue high school credit for this coursework.

FERPA Compliant: At Staggs, all students have a FERPA form on file, which allows for information to be shared with their parents. The school administration is available to serve as a mediator between students and professors in any necessary situation.
