## **Concurrent Enrollment**

An F-1 student may concurrently enroll in an approved school by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) if attendance at the other school is with prior written permission of the Primary/Designated School Official (P/DSO). Failure to receive prior permission may result in falling out of status. The combined number of hours enrolled must add up to a full course of study (12 hours for undergraduates and 6 hours for graduates) in the fall and spring semesters and at least half of the total credit hours must be taken at TAMIU. The course work at the other school must **not** be vocational and must be accepted for fulfilling your degree requirements at the school that issued the form I-20.
