SECTION NUMBERING SCHEME

1st character indicates semester/term: Fall = 1 Flex I 7-week = 6 Flex II 7-week = 7

2nd character indicates the time/type of 0 = Before 5 pm C = Clinical class: 6 = After 5 pm H = Hybrid 7 = Weekend L = Laboratory

8 = Distance Ed M = Applied/Ensemble Music

9 = Independent Study

3rd character indicates class days: MWF – odd numbers (e.g. 101, 103)

TR - even numbers (e.g. 102, 104)
