- I am submitting this form before the end of the term in which I intend to graduate. Yes No

Hours attempted include: every course registered for as of census date, transfer credit, credit earned exclusively by examination (first nine hours are excluded), courses dropped or withdrawn from after census date, optional internship and cooperative education courses, and repeated courses.

Hours attempted do not include: course credit that is earned to satisfy requirements for ROTC program, but that is not required to complete degree; course credit, other than credit earned exclusively by examination, that is earned before graduating high school; courses dropped for reasons that are determined by the institution to be totally beyond the control of the student; required teacher education courses shall not be counted to the extent that they are over and above the free electives allowed in the degree; developmental or remedial education.

NOTE: If you qualify for the tuition rebate, the rebate shall first be applied to any outstanding loans you may owe.
