



Figure 1. Total Fall Student Headcounts, 2018-2024

Figure 2. Total Fall Student Headcounts by College, 2018-2024






Figure 3. Total Headcount by Total Faculty, 2018-2024

Figure 4. Total Headcount by Total Full-Time Faculty, 2018-2024



Figure 5. ARSSB Headcount by Total Business Faculty, 2018-2024






Figure 6. ARSSB Headcount by Full-Time Faculty, 2018-2024





Figure 7. COED Headcount by Total Faculty, 2018-2024

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

Figure 9. CNHS Headcount by Total Faculty, 2018-2024






Figure 10. CNHS Headcount by Full-Time Faculty, 2018-2024





Figure 11. UC Headcount by Total Faculty, 2018-2024





Figure 13. COAS Headcount by Total Faculty, 2018-2024
