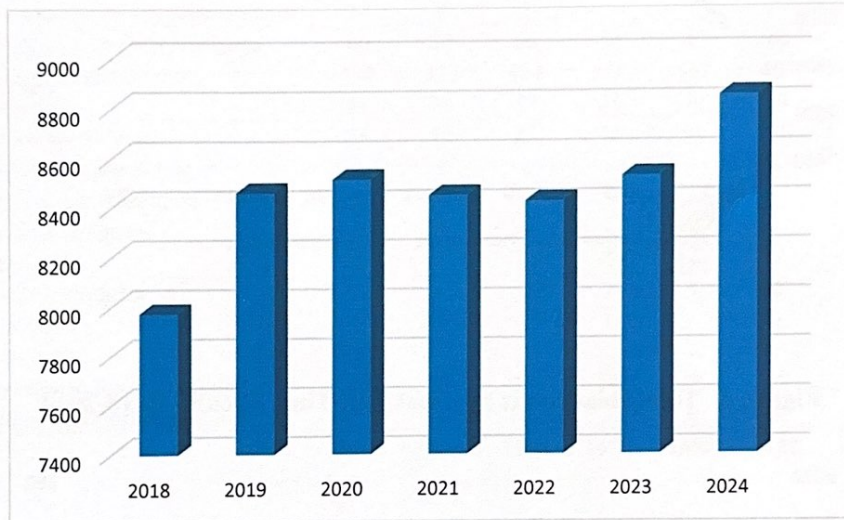

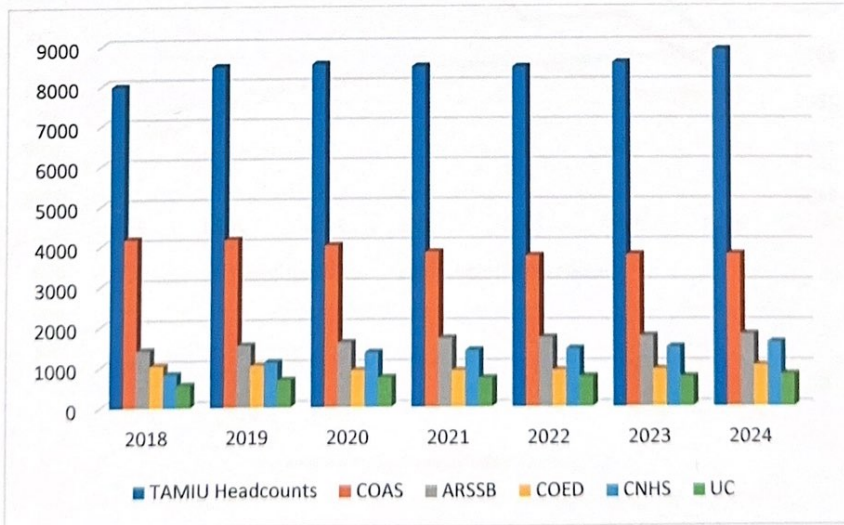

**Figure 1. Total Fall Student Headcounts, 2018-2024**

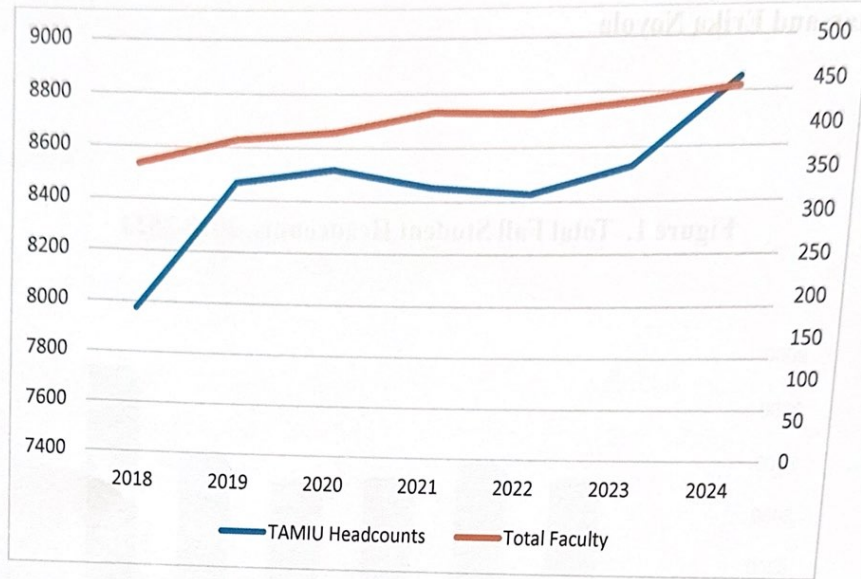


**Figure 2. Total Fall Student Headcounts by College, 2018-2024**

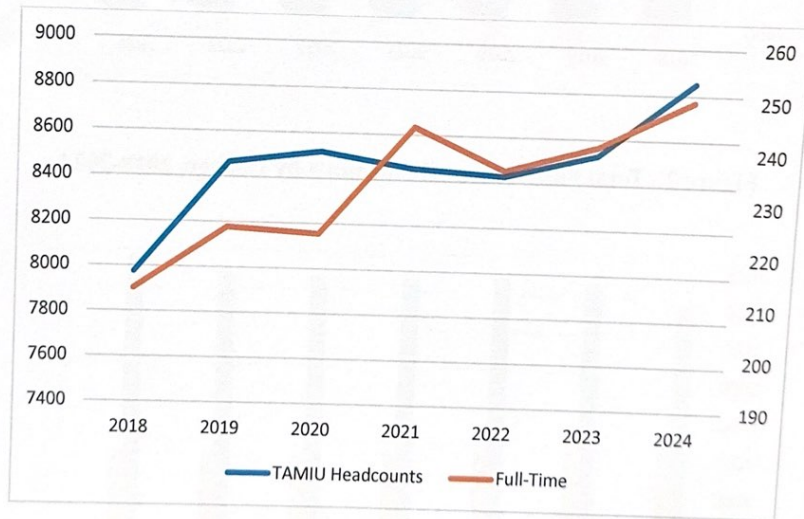




**Figure 3. Total Headcount by Total Faculty, 2018-2024**



**Figure 4. Total Headcount by Total Full-Time Faculty, 2018-2024**

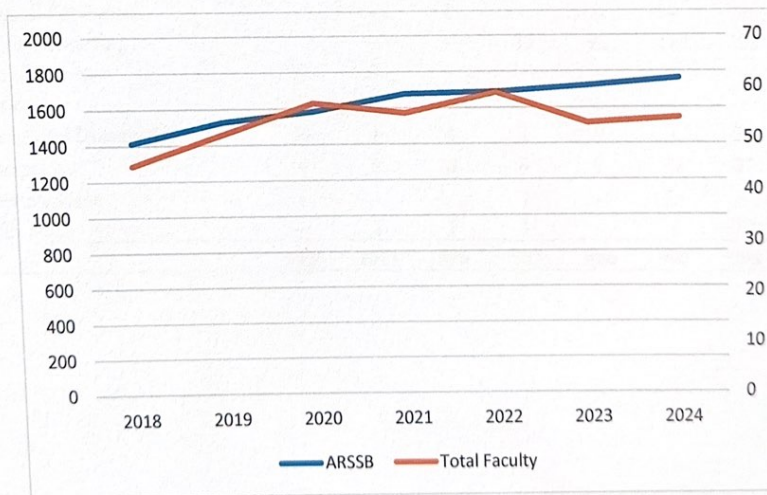

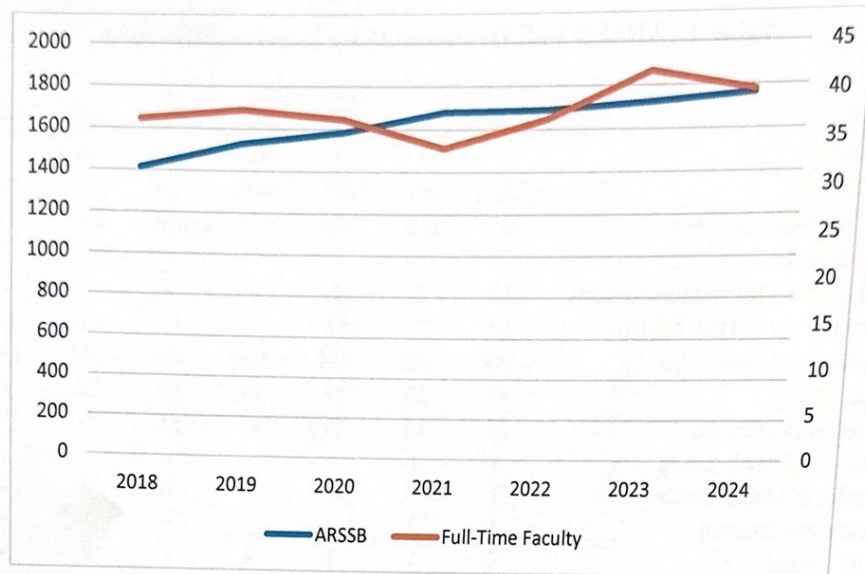

**Figure 6. ARSSB Headcount by Full-Time Faculty, 2018-2024**

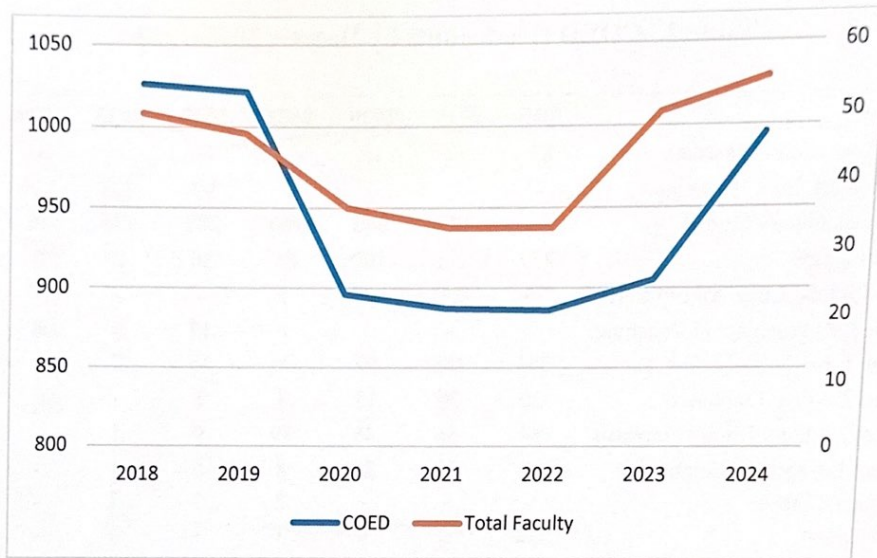

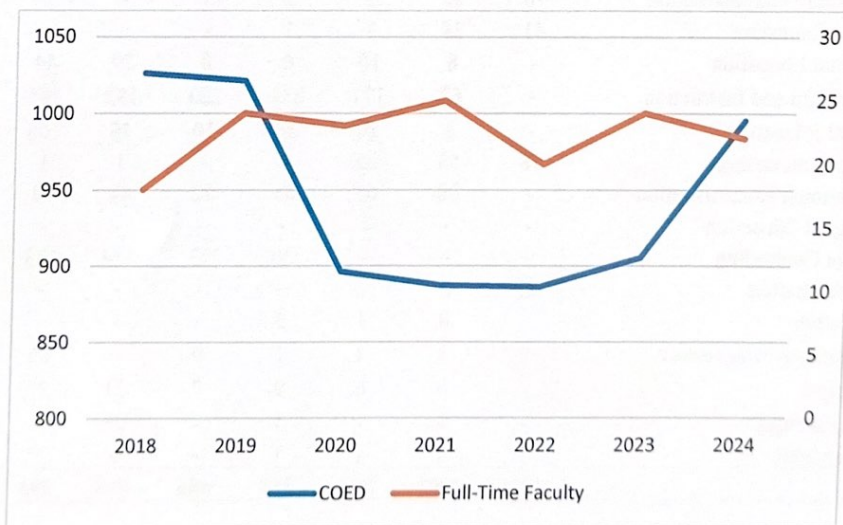

**Figure 8. COED Headcount by Full-Time Faculty, 2018-2024**

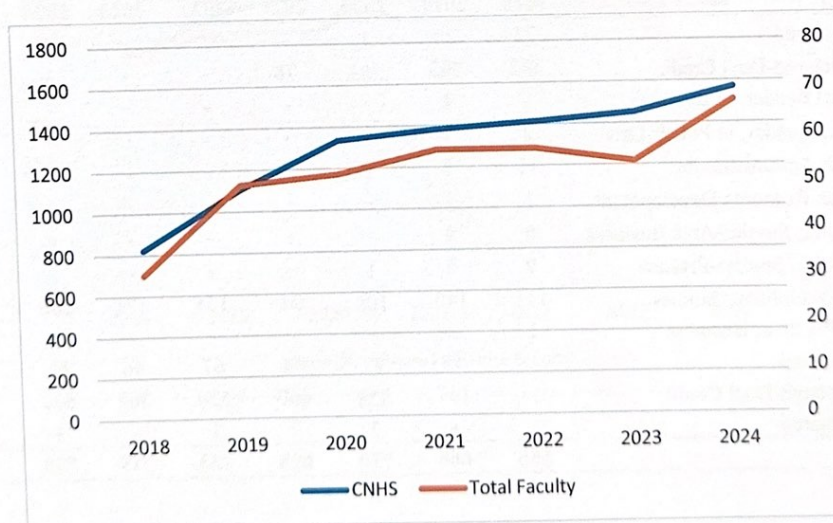

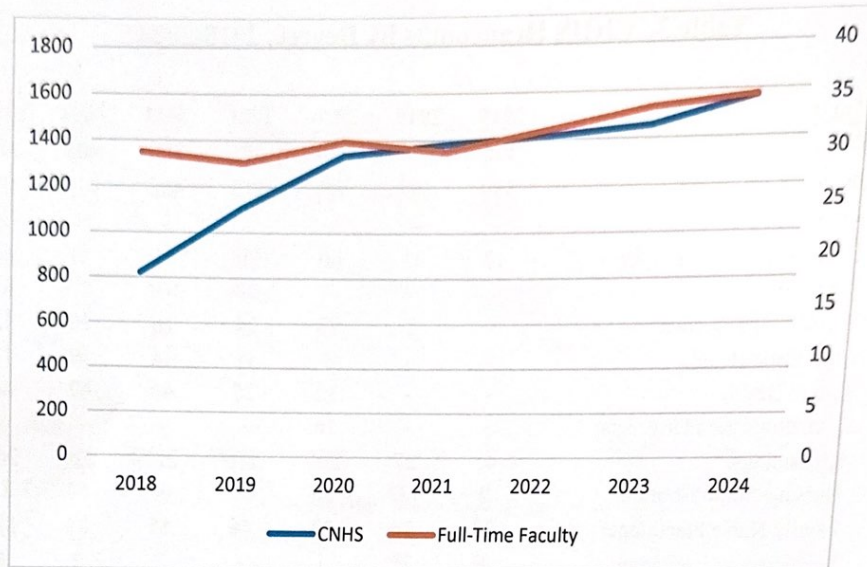

**Figure 10. CNHS Headcount by Full-Time Faculty, 2018-2024**

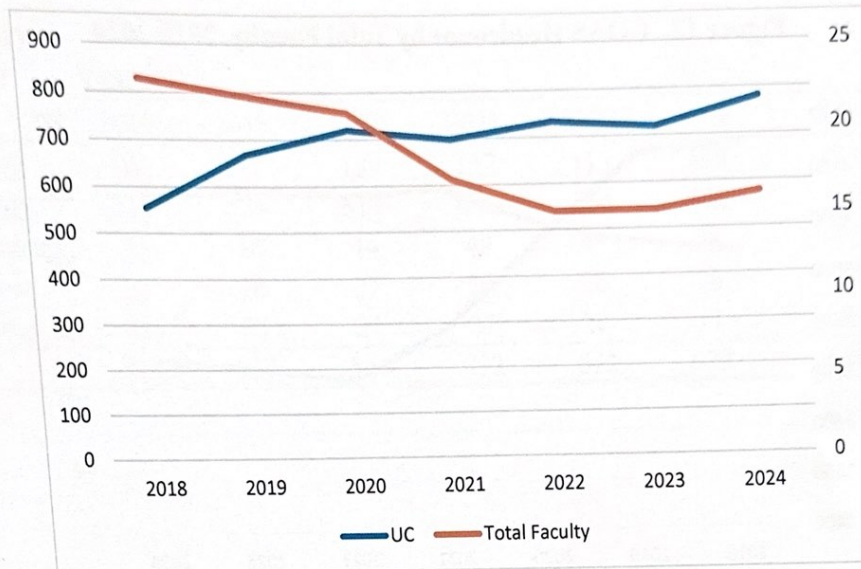

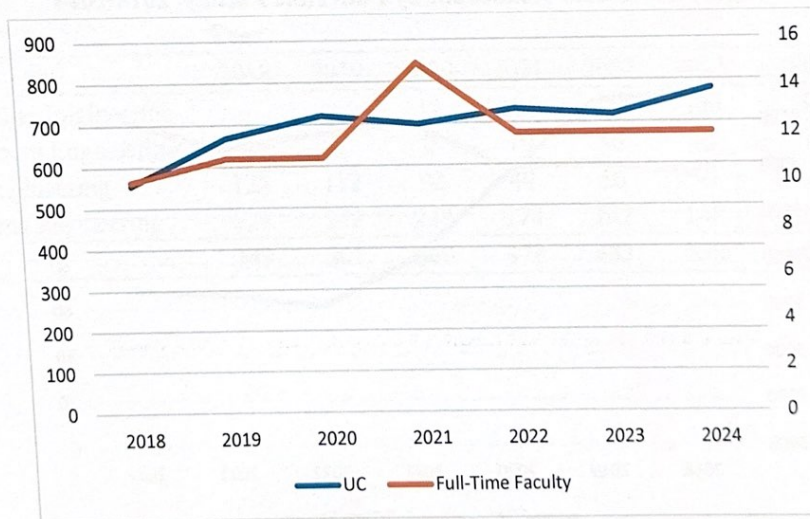

**Figure 11. UC Headcount by Total Faculty, 2018-2024**



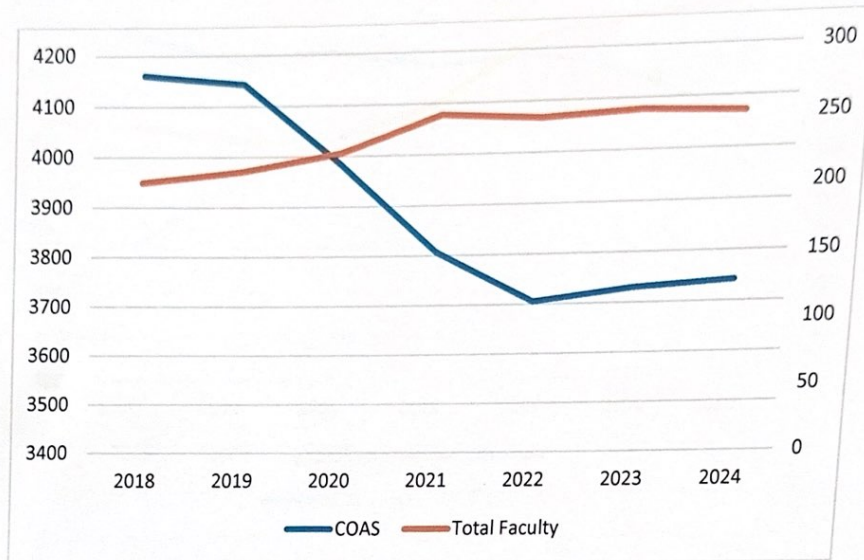
**Figure 12. UC Headcount by Full-Time Faculty, 2018-2024**



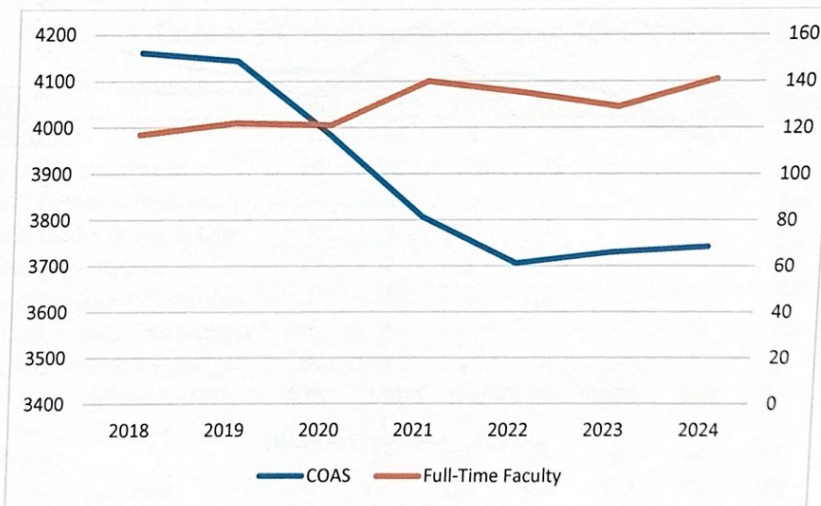
