Assignment Tasks

Follow these to complete your course assignments. Each assignment is broken down into manageable tasks. Take note of the recommended time spent to complete each task on time.

- **UNIT EXAMS / FINAL EXAM**
 - You will have 2 hours for each exam.
 - Make sure to study all the ID terms before exam and go over the PowerPoints provided by the professor. The PowerPoints will help you find connections between the ID terms, and they will put the terms into context. The ID terms will be provided to you by the professor on Blackboard. This will make it easier to answer the short essay questions in the exam.
 - Take about three weeks to study and prepare for the exams ahead of time. Plan to study 2 hours per day.
- **PRIMARY SOURCE ASSIGNMENT**
 - You will read one primary source document from the selection posted on Blackboard. You will then respond to a set of posted questions on Blackboard.

Make sure you are familiar with the ID terms and go over the PowerPoints and the assigned readings to answer the questions the best way possible.

- Take about two weeks to complete this assignment ahead of time before the deadline.
- **ANALYSIS PAPER**
 - You will identify a current issue related to either the African continent, the Indian subcontinent, or the Middle East and trace its historical context. Each Unit covers one region (Africa, India, Middle East), so make sure you keep up with the assigned readings for each Unit to be able to trace the history of the region you choose the current events of the region.
 - Once you pick your topic, meet with your professor to receive feedback on the topic and any needed tips.
 - Take at least two weeks to complete this assignment ahead of time before the deadline.
